HOME LEARNING PROJECT-YEAR 3 AND 4

KNOWLEDGE

Research 'The Ancient Mayans' and create an A4 sized book to share. Who were they? Are there modern Mayans? Think about including the following: hieroglyphics, codices, lives of ancient Mayans, Mayan Gods and Goddesses, Mayan numbers, the lost cities and any other information that is of interest to you.

Your home learning challenge this half term is based on our next topic, The Mayan Civilisation. Choose at least 2 activities to do and present them in any way you choose. (PowerPoint, video diary, poster or fact file. All work must be completed to a high standard and be handed into school to share with the class by Monday 13th March.

KNOWLEDGE

Present a poster including drawings and written descriptions of your own **Aztec** God. Think about what it looks like as well as what God-like qualities it has.



EVALUATING

Create a fact file on Ancient Mayans foods and their significance in Mayan times. Can you find out what Mayan people eat today and how similar or different their diet is compared to their ancestors?

Create your own 3D chocolate bar wrapper and think about branding. On top of this, you need to compose a jingle to advertise your chocolate bar! A combined Art and Music task for the keen Rock Steady Bands!

CREATE

Masks played a central role in Mayan culture. Create your own 3D Mayan mask. Additionally, produce a presentation to accompany your art piece to share your findings of why, how, when masks were used in Mayan times.

APPLY

Make a chocolate dessert to share with your friends and teacher! You may choose to design your very own dessert with a twist. Write up the recipe so it can be shared with the class whether it is a classic or an original.

<u>ANALYSING</u>

Research, prepare and deliver a 2 minute speech on whether **chocolate** is healthy or not. Include relevant facts, current statistics and be confident to take and respond to questions from the audience.
