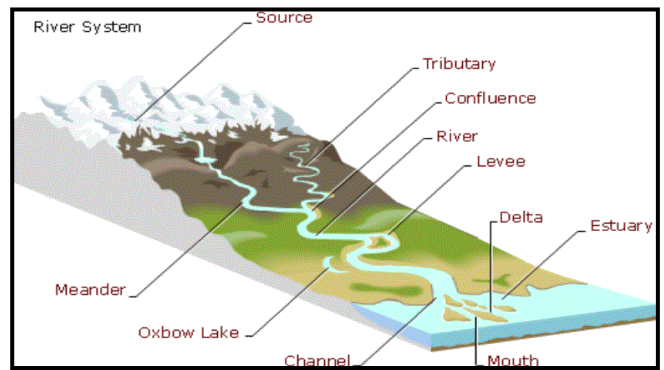


Year 5 Writing Project
