Summer 2 Term Learning Letter 2025

In English, we are learning to write stories from a character's point of view looking at 'Grandma's Seaside Bloomers'. We will develop our knowledge of adjectives and build great descriptive sentences. We will strengthen our knowledge of non-fiction texts by writing a recount about our trip to the seaside. We will use a wide range of appropriate vocabulary and our best punctuation. We will explore a range of poems and how to perform them. We will continue to work on our handwriting and concentrate on the size and form of our letters. We will start to join out letters in the correct places.

In Maths, we will continue to build our knowledge of number by using Place Value to compare and estimate numbers.

We will continue to learn our 2, 5 and 10 x tables and use inverse to learn related division facts.

We will explore and calculate money, capacity, shapes and tables and diagrams.

In Art, we will decorate our beach bags using a range of techniques. We will use fabric crayons and apply decorations. We will control the different types of marks made with a range of media such as crayons, pastels, felt tips, pen and chalk.

Our Learning Theme is ...

'Oh I do like to be beside the seaside'

In RE, we will study How should we care for others and the world, and why does it matter? We will explore how different faiths look after people and what they believe.

In History, we will study the changes within living memory focussing on the Seaside in the past. We will look at how life at the seaside has evolved over time and how people spent their time at the seaside in the past. We will explore how the seaside in the past was different to the seaside now. We will explore how the introduction of trains changed seaside holidays.

In Science, we will study and explore how Plants grow. We will look at what a plant needs to grow and what each part is and does. We will observe plants and observe how it changes over time.

- In RHE/ PSHE, we will be looking at Dealing with change and loss. We will discuss that death and loss is a part of life and talk about how to deal with death and loss. We will talk about death and that it can be positive and reflect on death and loss.











Please share your child's reading book with them, as 10-15 minutes of reading every day at home can make a lot of difference to your child's reading ability.
