Uniform Reminders

Recently I have noticed that a lot of children have not been wearing the correct uniform to school.

Our Uniform Policy is designed to:

- Promote the ethos of the academy
- Provide a sense of belonging and identity
- Set an appropriate tone for learning in the academy

Pupils are expected to wear their uniform correctly, responsibly and with pride. Staff will praise pupils verbally for their presentation where appropriate. If the child is not wearing the appropriate uniform they will be asked why, supported to wear uniform from school spares and reminded to wear their own uniform the next day. If children persistently do not wear the correct uniform, school will contact parents to discuss the issue.

Pupils are not permitted to wear:

- Jewellery except for one small stud earring in each pierced ear and a watch (not a Smart watch)
- Coloured hair accessories that are not school colours
- Make-up including nail varnish/ false nails
- Caps, jeans
- Haircuts with heavily shaved patterns into the head

It is important to us that we do not place a financial burden on families which is why we offer a Uniform Bank in school. Drop-in sessions are available in the Community Room every Monday from 9 - 10am or alternatively contact the school office on 0161 368 1898 or email info@greenfield.theharmonytrust.org to arrange a time to view available uniform.

Over the summer holiday, please can you ensure your child has the correct uniform ready to come back to school in September looking smart!
